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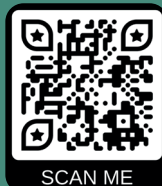

Summer is well and truly underway in Beccles



Beccles Lido is next to the beautiful River Waveney, the gateway to the Broads National Park. With a selection of hire craft including canoes, kayaks and paddleboards, plus the refurbished Big Dog Ferry, what better way to spend a summers day than exploring the river. Paddle towards the quay, wave as you pass the Waveney Hotel and the gardens along Northgate, or head to the Locks Inn Community pub in Geldeston by paddle or electric ferry.

Big Dog Ferry has been converted to electric, for a more leisurely and tranquil sailing to the Locks Inn along the river, where you can spot otters, kingfishers, swans with their cygnets and marsh harriers. Last year a pair of Osprey took up residence and will hopefully return. Stay on board for a round trip, disembark to enjoy a meal, drink or music, or take a one-way ticket and walk back on delightful riverside footpaths.

Beccles Lido is open every day, with the main pool, toddler pool and splash pool all heated to 28°C. The pool is surrounded by patios and grassy areas, with picnic tables and sunloungers, plus two all-weather eating and spectating areas.



There's also a children's adventure play area and a cafe serving hot and cold snacks, including ice creams and stone baked pizzas, plus drinks and lots more. With lane swimming early morning and evening, regular aquacise classes, and fun sessions in between, plus a springboard, slide and giant inflatable sessions at weekends and daily during the summer holidays, there's splashtastic fun for everyone!

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Top tips for travelling with your pet

Travelling with your pet can be a wonderful experience, but a little preparation goes a long way in making the journey safe and stress-free.

Firstly, make sure your pet is wearing an up-to-date ID tag and that their microchip details are correct. It's worth getting extra tags with your mobile number and holiday address.

Don't forget -food, water, bowls, medication, a lead, poo bags or litter and tray, bedding and a favourite toy or blanket to provide reassurance in unfamiliar surroundings. Even in pet friendly accommodation, I take extra throws and blankets to protect the furniture.

Plan stops every couple of hours so your pet can stretch their legs and have a drink. Ask your vet about products that can treat travel sickness or help calm your pet during the journey.



Before you go research the local veterinary practices, and put their number in your phone, just in case.

If you're going abroad, have you checked the paperwork you need. Requirements frequently change. Check at www.gov.uk/taking-your-pet-abroad,

Vaccinations are needed for kennels and catteries and also for taking your pet to Europe. Make sure they are up to date well in advance of your booking.

Ask your vet about the risks your pet may encounter in warmer parts of Europe. There are several serious diseases, some of which can be spread to people, that we do not find in the UK.

Finally, think about your pet's temperament. Not every animal enjoys travelling, and for some, staying with a trusted friend, family member or reputable boarding facility may be the kinder option.

From Friday 11 – Sunday 20 September, people across Norfolk and beyond can enjoy hundreds of **free events** during the Norfolk Heritage Open Days festival, from hidden historic buildings and guided walks to family activities, exhibitions and talks.

In 2025, Norfolk's programme featured 397 events from more than 200 local organisations, and Norwich hosted the largest city-wide programme in England.

The online event directory for this year's Heritage Open Days festival is now live, with over 250 events already, making it easy to plan ten days of discovering stories, places, and passions.

The Forum is bringing back an extended version of the popular Portraits of Life exhibition of photographs by Jack Roberts, originally premiered in 2019, showing Norwich after the Second World War and before the city's redevelopment in the early 1970s.

The exhibition will also feature archive films and recorded stories from people who lived and worked there.

The printed Norfolk Heritage Open Days listings brochure will be available from late July at The Forum, Norwich and other selected venues across the county.

As events can still be registered up to Thursday 13 August, not every listing will appear in the printed brochure, so do check the online directory regularly for updates and booking information.

So, get out and experience the incredible heritage and history our county has to offer this September with hundreds of amazing events, that are **all entirely FREE!**

Booking opens for the majority of Norfolk's prebook events from Wed 26 Aug, but there are plenty of drop-in events too!

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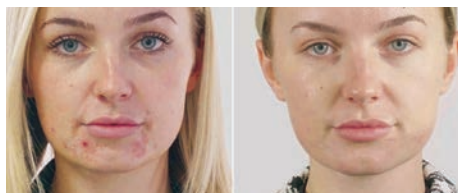


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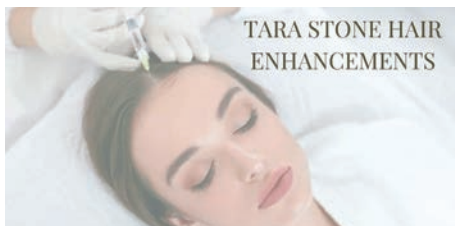


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Theatre Royal volunteer credits opportunity for making life "worth living"

"I love being around people, and I knew I'd miss being social post-retirement. I've volunteered for 25 years now. It's so rewarding that I now volunteer for local festivals, summer sessions, the Lord Mayor's Parade, and in a charity shop. It's great fun feeling part of a team."

Janey says being in the community is key to maintaining her health and wellbeing. "Sitting at home can make you rather fed up, so volunteering with others makes a huge difference. I always come home feeling refreshed. When visitors at the theatre say thank you and smile, it makes me feel so appreciated. You make so many friends; it makes life worth living.

"You're never too old to take part. Pluck up the courage and go along to a group, or volunteer. Mentally and emotionally, being with other people is wonderful. If you're feeling down, there's nothing like being with others - you can often talk to people who feel the exact same way and you feel better afterwards. Don't leave it too late. Reach out while you still can and get out there!"

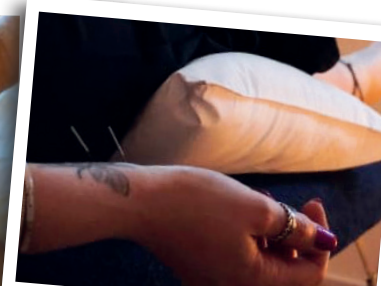
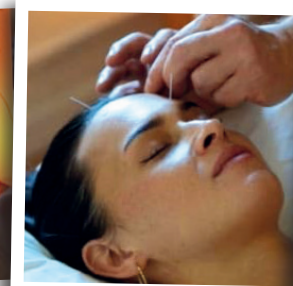

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Richard Penguin's Musical Triangle

Celebrating 20 years of this
music column.



Phew! It's been a scorching hot couple of months. Here is a short round up of some concerts that I managed to get to. On a sweltering hot evening in late June at UEA The Divine Comedy bookended their superb set reminding us of their extensive back catalogue of classic songs from 'Something for the weekend' and 'Alfie' as openers through to the amusing 'National Express' and rousing 'Tonight We fly' as conclusers. In between we were treated a range of newer material highlighting that main man Neil Hannon has not lost that ability to pen both tongue in cheek and heartfelt lyrical masterpieces. A fantastic concert. Meanwhile at The Holloway Adam Clark launched his marvellous Norfolk focused new album 'Folk and Fold' with local folk luminaries Nic Zuppari and Alex Patterson making up his trio. Taking inspiration from Norfolk tales and folk singers of old while 'Fakenham Fair' may have been sung by many Adam gave it a new twist by re-writing the 'problematic lyrics' and it fitted in well alongside his own compositions including 'I walked by night' inspired by a Norfolk poacher who was imprisoned in Norwich castle. A superb concert, and album, that is gaining lots of great reviews and airplay. While not my favourite musical genre Dereham Blues festival which takes over the whole town for 5 days in July had some good moments on the Saturday when I went notably Santiago and the Soul movers playing Joe Walsh and early Fleetwood Mac covers delivered by their flamboyant frontman, and Canadian Tim Lee with his hobo songs redolent of Seasick Steve. Meanwhile I really enjoyed the Lord Mayor's procession with some musical highlights including the energetic Indie pop inspired set from Archie and the Astronauts, The Flute fronted and fine psychedelic pop set from The Mink and the joyful set from the Mind the Gap band formed from musicians who lead or take part in this wonderful organisation who were deservedly chosen as the Lord Mayor's charity for this year's event.

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A warm roof is designed with insulation placed above the roof deck, which helps to keep heat within the living space below. This design minimizes heat loss during colder months, leading to lower energy bills and a more energy-efficient home.

COMFORT

By maintaining a consistent indoor temperature, warm roofs eliminate cold spots and drafts that can occur in traditional roofs. This results in a more comfortable living environment year-round.

CONDENSATION PREVENTION

Warm roofs help prevent condensation buildup within the roof structure. Since the insulation is above the roof deck, it reduces the temperature difference between the warm air inside and the cold roof surface, minimizing moisture issues.

REDUCED MAINTENANCE

With insulation protecting the roof deck from temperature fluctuations, warm roofs generally require less maintenance compared to cold roofs. This can lead to a longer lifespan for the roofing materials.

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
